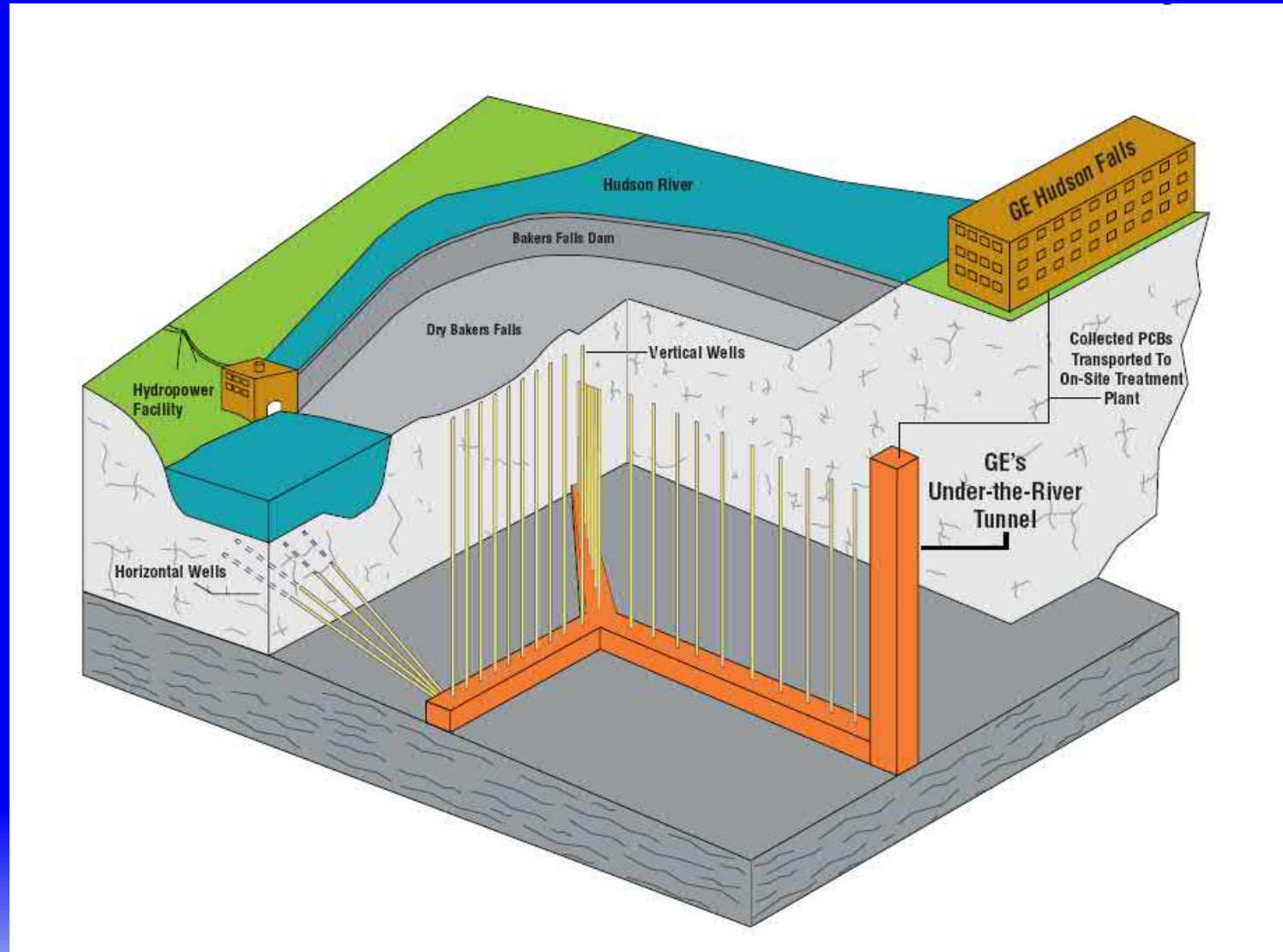


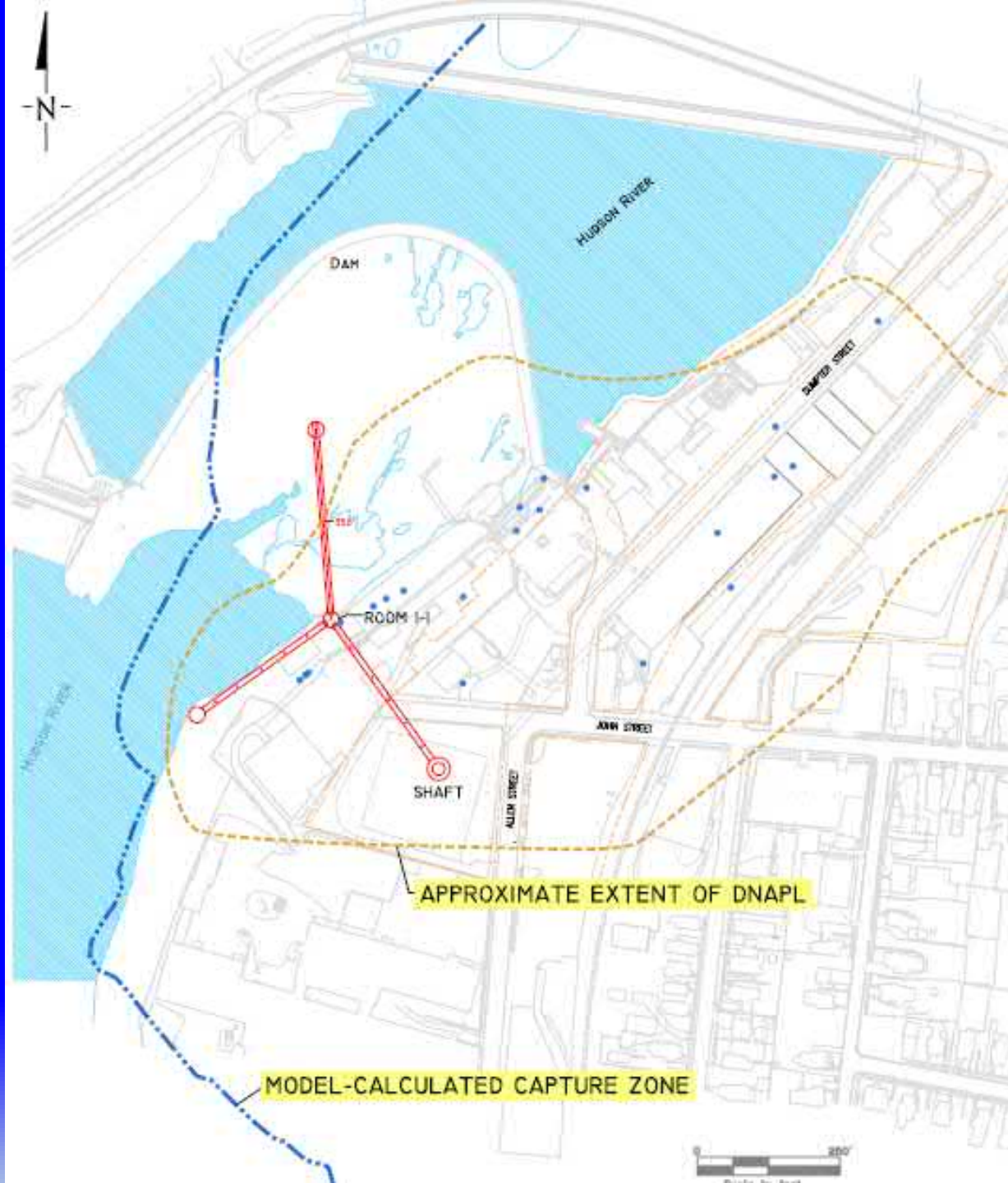




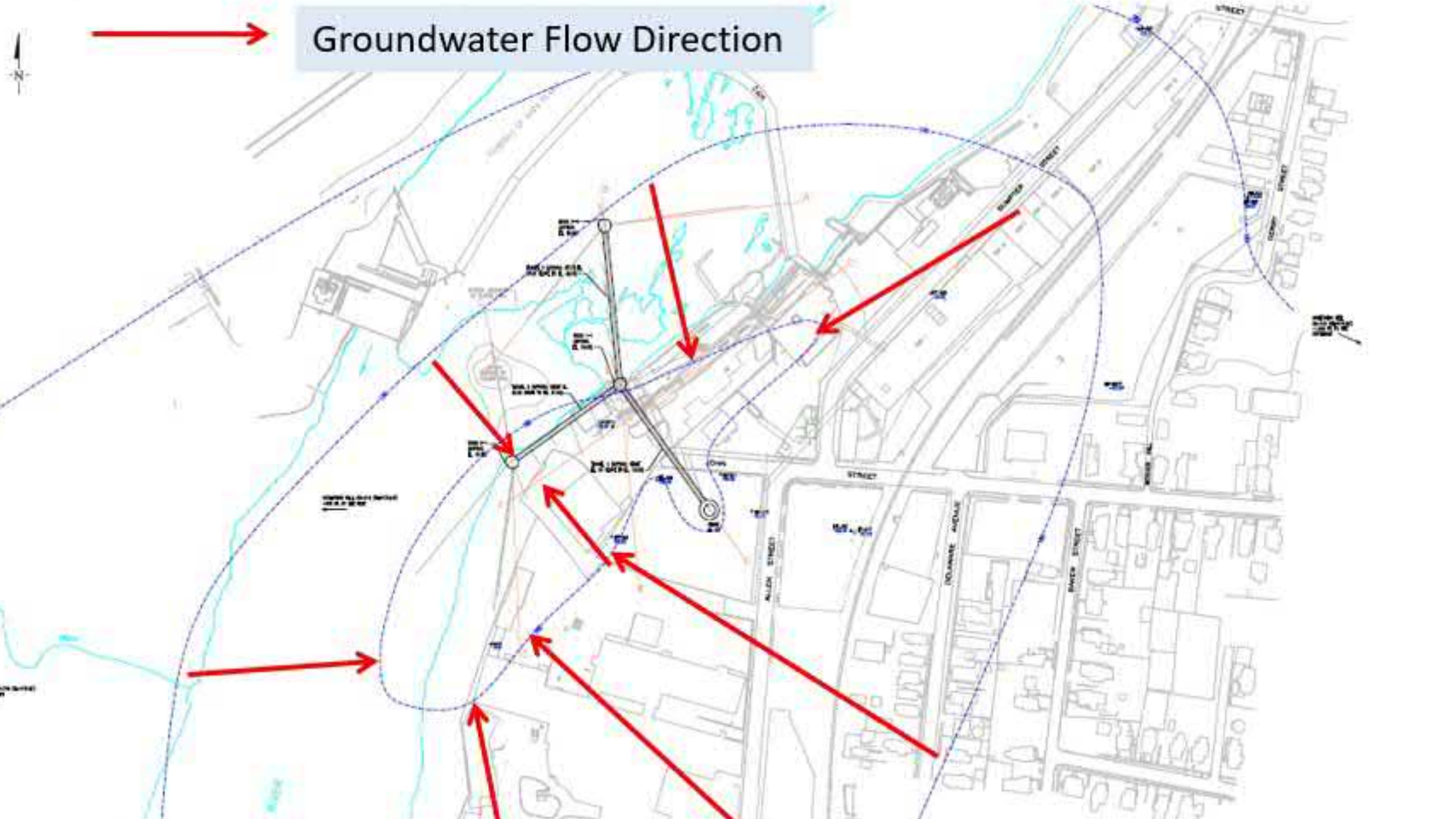


Final Tunnel Layout



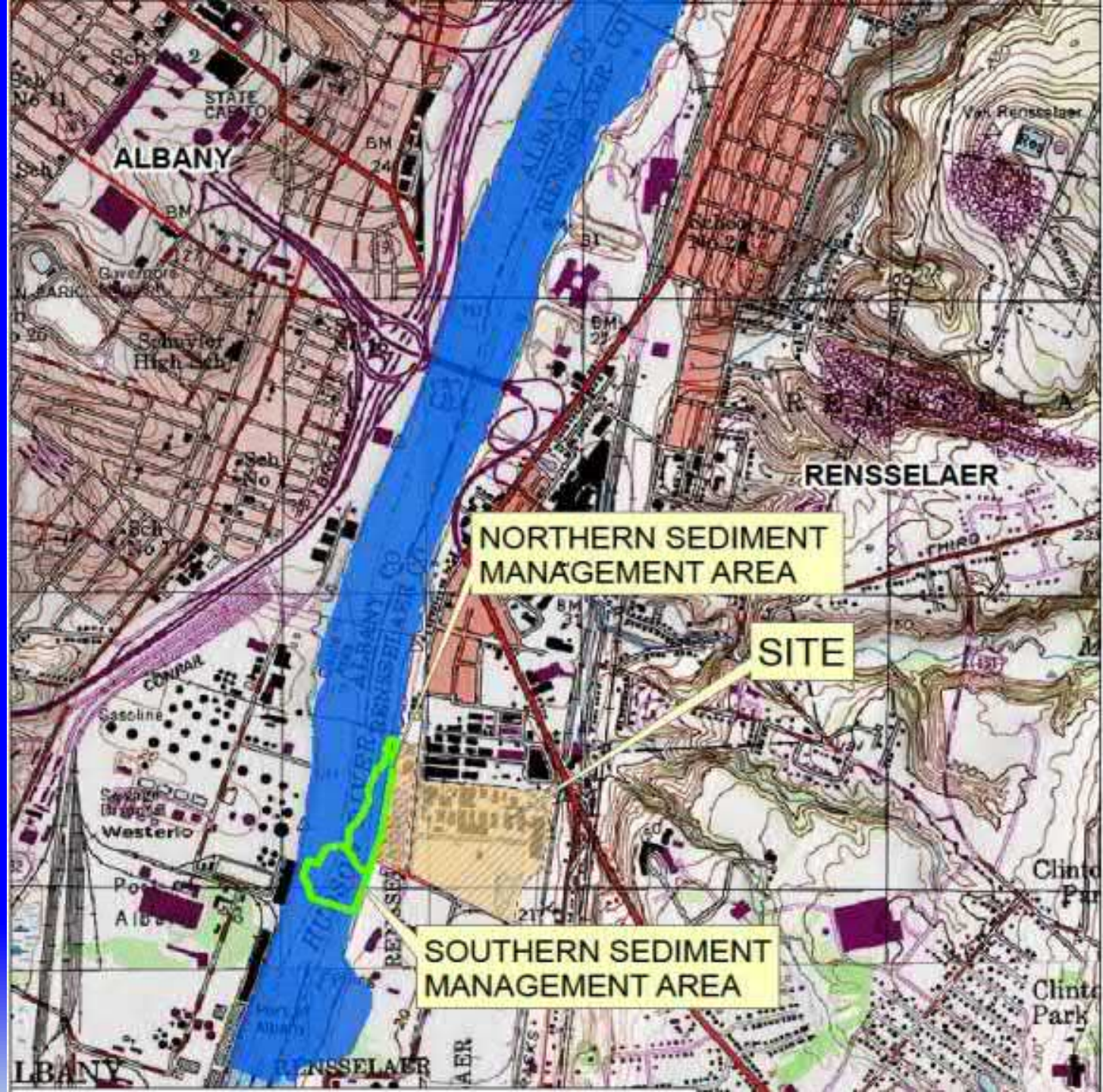


Groundwater Flow Direction
